

Yarn Fair Proved Itself to be the 2nd Biggest of the World with the Record Number of Visitors

14th International Istanbul Yarn Fair that took place thanks to Tüyap's hospitality, along with Knitting Tech 2017 and 26th International Knitting, Sock, Embroidery Machines and Subindustry Fairs held simultaneously ended with a great success.

The fairs, which were joined by 215 companies and company representatives from 18 countries, hosted a total of 8755 visitors with 1955 of foreigners and 6800 from home. Yarn & Knitting Tech Fairs bringing innovation, technology and functionality together, took its success to the highest level thanks to the high visitor rate throughout 4 four days as a trade platform, in which bilateral business relations were developed.
